

CALL FOR PAPERS

In addition to proposals related to the conference theme, topics related to social justice, diverse populations, and current practice issues are also encouraged.

Suggested topics include:

Papers and workshops are encouraged from students, faculty, field instructors and coordinators, program directors, and practitioners.

Proposals are limited to two submissions per author. Proposals are limited to 500 words and a brief 50-word description and must include the attached <u>Proposal Cover Sheet</u>.

Proposals and papers will be selected for presentation at the conference and for student awards, respectively, based on relevance/importance to social work education, innovativeness (e.g., presentation of new ideas, evidence, or skills), and technical quality (e.g., sentence structure, grammar, spelling, research design, statistical analysis, APA format). There should be no identifying information in the proposal in order to assure an anonymous review process.
